

Works – Carriageway Patching A508 Brixworth to Pitsford

Start date – 10th May 2019

Completion – 11th May 2019 (Weather Dependent)

Scheme type – Pre-Surface Dressing Patching

Traffic management - Road closure

Hours of work – 20:00-6:00

What we are doing/the benefits

This road has been selected to form part of this year's Surface Dressing programme. The first phase of these works is to carry out some pre-surface dressing preparation which will improve the structure/strength of the carriageway, removing any weak spots. The second phase which will be the Surface Dressing itself which, when bedded in it will considerably increase the lifespan of the road whilst also improving skid resistance. The Surface Dressing will take place during the summer.

When programming works we consider the impact on all road users and plan our works to minimise disruption. To maintain the health and safety of the workforce and the public the works will be carried out under a road closure with a diversion route in place. We do understand that road closures are inconvenient, but works can only be completed safely and efficiently with them in place. We hope any inconvenience will be tolerated for the duration of the works, as this scheme will significantly improve this route.

Please note that these works are dependent on good weather conditions.

Traffic Management

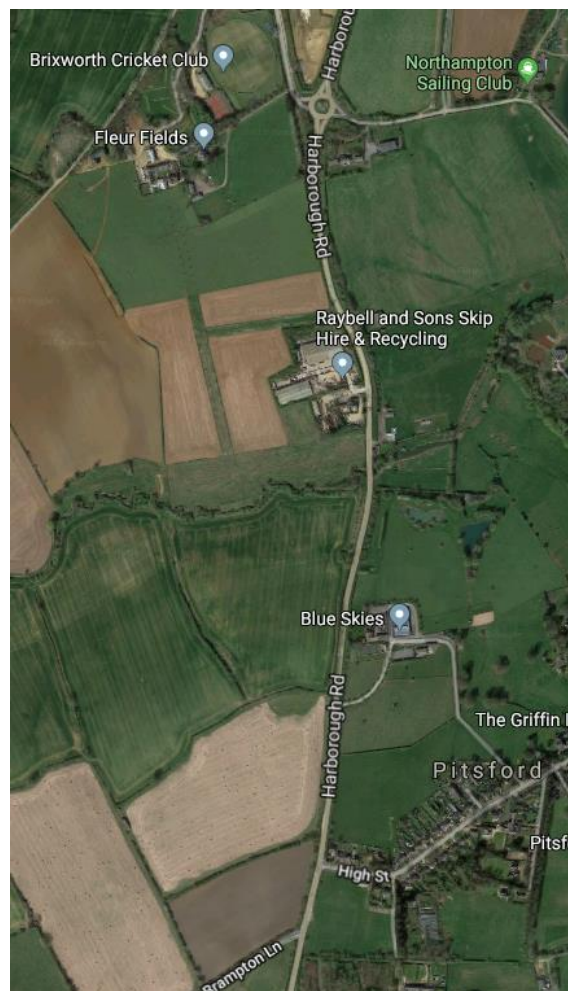

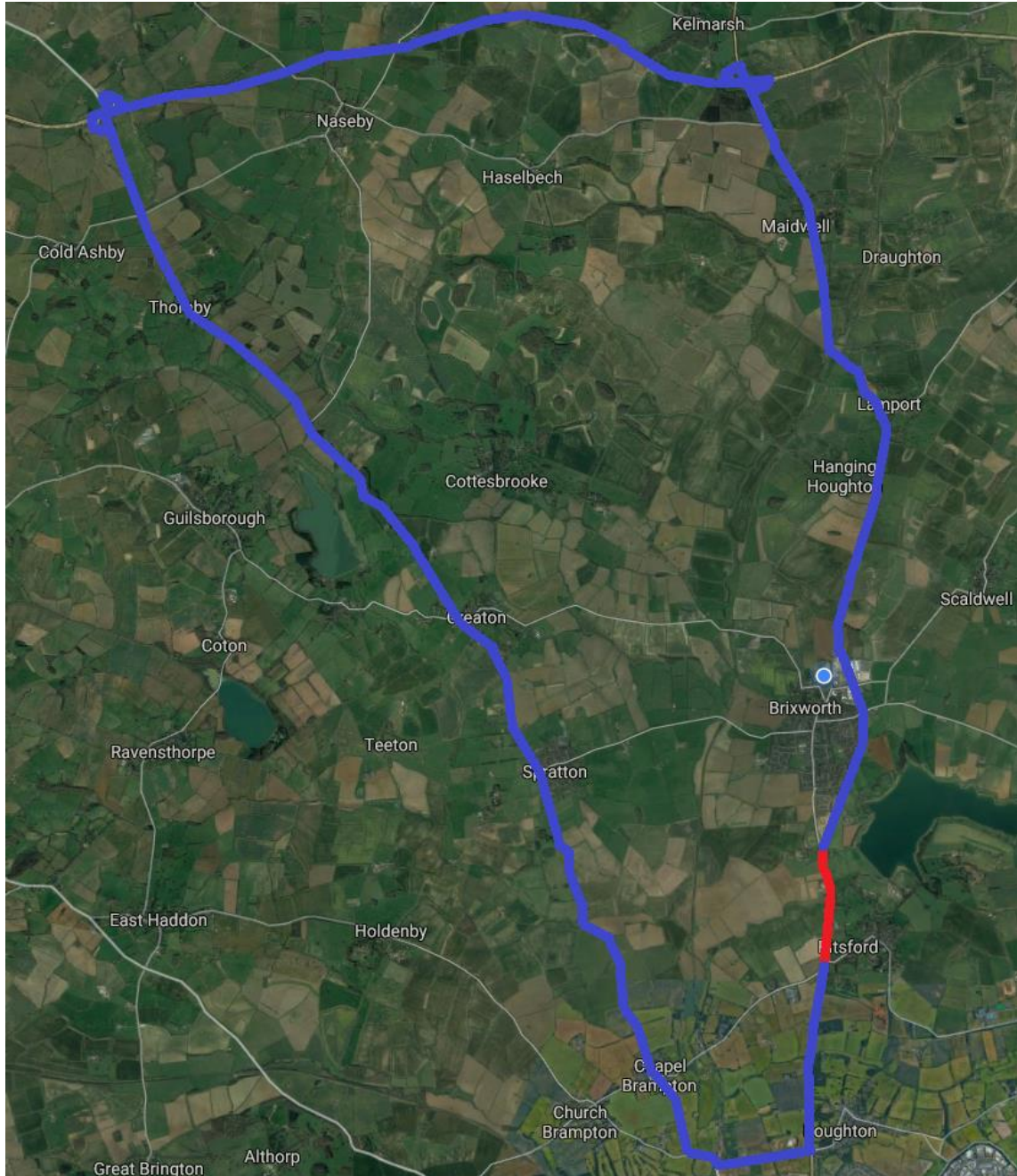
Information for residents and businesses
